Recruitment of a Native Lecturer in Chinese Language

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The Department of Eastern Languages, Faculty of Humanities, would like to recruit individuals to take the selection examination for university employees in the position of Lecturer, Chinese Language Section, to support the curriculum/courses that will be taught in the first semester of the 2026 academic year, with the following examination details:

**1. Applicant Qualifications**

Applicants must be qualified according to Section 1, General Chapter, Section 6, University Council Announcement. Kasetsart University Regulations on Personnel Administration for University Employees 2010 and have specific qualifications for the position as follows:

1.1 To be eligible for Thai citizenship or foreigners

1.2 Hold a doctorate or master's degree, or be currently pursuing a doctoral degree, in Chinese language and culture, Chinese literature, Teaching Chinese as a Second/Foreign Language, Chinese Linguistics, Eastern languages, or other related fields. Should have experience or understanding of educational quality assessment systems and curriculum development. If a research article that is not part of a thesis within the past 3 years is published, this will be given special consideration.

**2. Date, time, and place of application**

Those who wish to apply for the examination can apply now until Tuesday, June 30, 2026, at the Faculty of Humanities Secretariat Office, Room 303, 3rd Floor, Chulabhorn Phisan Silpa Building, Faculty of Humanities, Kasetsart University, Bangkhen, during office hours (applications are accepted from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.) Tel. 0 2579 5566 – 8 ext. 4352

**3. Documents and evidence to be submitted with the application form**

3.1 A 1 1/2 x 2-inch photo taken with a full face, without a hat or sunglasses, not more than 1 year taken (counting to the application closing date), 1 photo

3.2 A diploma and transcript of all levels of education, if completed studying abroad, requires submitting a translated diploma and transcript in English or Thai. The applicant must submit the original document and a copy of each.

3.3 Copy of English test results according to the following minimum criteria:

- TOEFL (Paper)	minimum score 550
- TOEFL (CBT)	minimum score 213
- TOEFL (IBT)	minimum score 79 – 80
- IELTS	minimum score 6.5
- CU-TEP	minimum score 75
- KU-EPT	minimum score 65
- TOEIC	minimum score 700

Completing a doctorate degree from a foreign university that uses English teaching and learning does not require submitting English test results.

3.5 If there are any academic work will be given special consideration.

3.6 A copy of the document of change of title, name change, or surname change (in case of any changes), such as a copy of the marriage certificate, a copy of the divorce decree for married women, etc., one copy of each.

3.7 A copy of each of the house registrations, birth certificates, national ID cards, and military service certificates.

3.8 A medical certificate showing that the patient does not have any prohibited according to the Civil Service Commission's regulations on diseases with the following characteristics: Prohibited from being a civil servant in a higher education institution, 2006, dated December 4, 2006, a copy of the certificate issued no more than 1 month ago.

3.9 Three guarantors who are not the father, mother, husband, wife, sibling, or full-blooded person who are well acquainted with the applicant fill out a certification form on a confidential document set by the committee. One of the guarantors must be a civil servant or permanent employee, or if in the military or police, must have a rank of no lower than Captain. (Can be submitted later)

3.10 A copy of a resume in Thai and English or English and Chinese, including contact details such as phone number and the guarantor's address from the previous workplace (if there is any).

**4. Announcement of names of those eligible to take the exam** on Monday, July 6, 2026, at the Faculty of Humanities Secretariat Office, Room 303, 3rd floor, Chulabhorn Phisan Silpa Building, Faculty of Humanities, Kasetsart University, Bangkok, during office hours.

**5. Written Examination** on Wednesday, July 8, 2026 Time 09.00 - 11.00 hrs. at Meeting Room 1, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Humanities Building 2, Kasetsart University, Bangkok

**6. Interview and teaching demonstration** on Wednesday, July 8, 2026, Time 13.00 – 15.00 hrs. At Meeting Room 1, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Humanities Building 2 Kasetsart University, Bangkok

**7. Announcement of the names of those who passed the teaching demonstration and are eligible to take the psychological test.** On Monday, July 13, 2026, At the Office of the Secretary of the Faculty of Humanities, Room 303, 3rd Floor, Chulabhorn Phisan Silpa Building, Faculty of Humanities, Kasetsart University, Bangkok, during office hours. The faculty will announce the schedule for psychological testing later.


**11. Announcement of the list of candidates who passed the selection exam**
