Kasetsart University - Announcement

on Attendee Qualifications for Joining the Graduation Ceremony and its Rules of Conduct

For the success of Kasetsart University's 2023 graduation ceremony, the University has listed the qualifications and its rules of conduct for all the attendees as follows;

Qualification of the Graduates who will receive their diploma

- Graduates must have completed their respective curricula approved by the Kasetsart University
 Council or have completed their curriculum in the prior academic year and approved by the council or those who will receive their honorary diploma.
- 2. Bachelor degree graduates must have already fulfilled their obligations of attending all categories of extracurriculars with no less than 8 activities and participating in the English proficiency exams.
- 3. Graduates must attend the rehearsal for the graduation ceremony as per the University's announcement.

Rules of conduct for the attendees of the graduation ceremony

1. Graduates must attend the mini-rehearsal on their respective date, time, and location as specified by their faculties and must attend the main rehearsal on their date, time, and location as dictated by the University, those who fail to attend neither one of the rehearsals may result in their disqualification for the graduation ceremony.

Graduates can request to postpone their Graduation to the next academic year once. The request must be submitted during the graduation ceremony's registration date as announced by the University. In case of an accident during the rehearsal and the graduation ceremony, the postponed request must be submitted within 7 working days after the last day of the graduation ceremony.

- 2. Graduates must register to the graduate registry per the University's instructions.
- 3. Graduates must bring and carry their identification card issued by the government during the rehearsals and the graduation ceremony, and readily available for inspection.
- 4. Graduates must strictly adhere to the instructions of the rehearsal and graduation ceremony organizing subcommittee during the rehearsals and the graduation ceremony.
 - 5. Dress code
 - 5.1 Hair and nails

Male graduates

Modest haircut, no longer than the base of the neck. No unnatural hair dyeing, spraying, or highlighting of any color. No wearing of toupee or hairpieces. No beards, mustaches, or sideburns. Keep your nails trimmed. Do not apply any color, nail polish, or artificial nails.

Female graduates

Modest haircut. No unnatural hair dyeing, spraying, or highlighting of any color. No wearing of toupee or hairpieces. Keep your nails trimmed. Do not apply any color, nail polish, or artificial nails. Muslim graduates are allowed to wear black hijab.

5.2 Attires for mini-rehearsal

Male graduates of all levels

Wear attire as instructed in the latest Kasetsart University student handbook edition. With the exception, that the trousers must be in navy blue.

Female bachelor's graduates

Wear attire as instructed in the latest Kasetsart University student handbook edition. With the exception, that the skirt must be in navy blue. Muslim graduates are allowed to wear white, long-sleeved shirts with navy blue, long skirts according to their religious guidance.

Female master's and doctorate graduate

Wear a plain, white collared shirt with no back pleats. No tight-fitting clothes. No embroidery or patterns. Cylindrical sleeves above the elbow shirt. Wear a modest style, navy-blue, knee-covered

skirt. No jeans. Muslim graduates are allowed to wear white, long-sleeved shirts with navy blue, long skirts according to their religious guidance.

5.3 Attires for main-rehearsal

Male graduates of all levels

Wear proper attire for the Royal ceremony as instructed in the latest Kasetsart University student handbook edition, with a non-pattern, navy-blue suit. Civil servants may dress in their official 'white uniform'. Those with military or police rank, including those reserve officers with acting second lieutenant rank or higher, may wear their uniforms according to the dress code of the Ministry of Defense and Royal Thai Police.

Wear the academic gown on top of the attire or uniform with a graduation cap, decorated with a tassel and colored according to your faculty. The gown must be one foot above the ground while standing. Jewelry, flowers, or any decoration on the gown are not allowed, except the academic medal of Honor on the left chest.

Female bachelor's graduates

Wear proper attire for the Royal ceremony as instructed in the latest Kasetsart University student handbook edition, with a navy-blue skirt. Muslim graduates are allowed to wear white, long-sleeved shirts with navy blue, long skirts according to their religious guidance. Civil servants may dress in their official 'white uniform'. Those with military or police rank, including those reserve officers with acting second lieutenant rank or higher, may wear their uniforms according to the dress code of the Ministry of Defense and Royal Thai Police.

Wear the academic gown on top of the attire or uniform with a graduation cap, decorated with a tassel and colored according to your faculty. The gown must be one foot above the ground while standing. No jewelry, flower, or any decoration on the gown, except the academic medal of Honor on the left chest.

Female master's and doctorate graduate

Wear a plain, white collared shirt with no back pleats. No tight-fitting clothes. No embroidery or patterns. Cylindrical sleeves above the elbow shirt. Wear a modest style, navy-blue, knee-covered skirt. No jeans. Muslim graduates are allowed to wear white, long-sleeved shirts with navy blue, long

skirts according to their religious guidance. Civil servants may dress in their official 'white uniform'. Those with military or police rank, including those reserve officers with acting second lieutenant rank or higher, may wear their uniforms according to the dress code of the Ministry of Defense and Royal Thai Police.

Wear the academic gown on top of the attire or uniform with a graduation cap, decorated with a tassel and colored according to your faculty. The gown must be one foot above the ground while standing. No jewelry, flower, or any decoration on the gown, except the academic medal of Honor on the left chest.

5.4 Shoes

Male graduates of all levels

Wear black-leather shoes with no embroidery, patterns, or metal-plated soles. Wear black, non-pattern socks. Those with military or police rank, including those reserve officers with acting second lieutenant rank or higher, must wear according to the dress code of the Ministry of Defense and Royal Thai Police.

Female graduates of all degree

Wear black-leather, flat or low-heel, toe-covering shoes with no embroidery, patterns, or metalplated soles. Stiletto heels are not allowed. Wear skin-toned, non-pattern stockings. Those with military or police rank, including those reserve officers with acting second lieutenant rank or higher, must wear according to the dress code of the Ministry of Defense and Royal Thai Police.

5.5 Prohibited items during the main rehearsal and Graduation ceremony

- Weapons and all kinds of sharp objects
- Watches, wristbands, blessed threads, rings, bracelets, earrings, necklaces
- Mobile phones, any communication devices, audio recorders, cameras, handheld fans
- Makeup; lipstick, mirrors, perfume, facial paper
- Stationary accessories, books, documents, wallets, purses, and handbags
- Food, drinks, snacks, all kinds of candies, gum

Notice: All violations of items described above will be confiscated by the rehearsal and graduation ceremony organizing subcommittee, which will not be liable for any damages or loss of said seized items.

6. If the graduates cannot follow the rules of conduct listed above, they must submit a formal request, stating their reasonings. All requests will be under the consideration and jurisdiction of the rehearsal and graduation ceremony organizing subcommittee.

The president of the rehearsal and graduation ceremony organizing subcommittee oversees the process following this announcement.
